



# PATROL CAPTAIN MENTOR PROGRAM 2011

## **Overview:**

The aim of the PCMP is to give the participants from the ages of 16-25 the opportunity to develop their skills and give them the knowledge to be a patrol captain on their beach.

## **The Program:**

The program is spanning over 2 seasons, incorporating the required branch facilitated courses that the participants will need. It is expected that the participants complete the required club trained courses which are pre-requisites to the branch courses.

The aim for the participants is to work towards the Silver Medallion Basic Beach Management course. For this course the participants will be required to be proficient in their Bronze Medallion/Cert II in Public Safety.

Each participant within the course will be required to be a patrol vice-captain. This will allow them to be mentored through their own clubs. Each club will need to nominate a PCMP mentor which will assist in building the skills of the participant. These mentors will be required to attend a briefing session at the branch office to assist them with their role. The participants will also be allocated a Branch Mentor. This person will assist with any question and assist the club mentors with their role.

Throughout the course the participants will be required to complete some patrols in the SLSSNB Radio room (SurfCom). This will give the participants an insight on what happens throughout the branch.
