### NOMINATION INFORMATION

Nominations are now open for the 2019/2020 Surf Life Saving Sydney Northern Beaches (SLSSNB) Interbranch Team who will be representing the Branch at the 2019 NSW Interbranch Championships to be conducted at Bulli on the weekend of **December 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> 2019**.

Competitors are invited to nominate by completing the Interbranch Nomination Form that will be circulated to all Clubs and made available on the SLSSNB Website. The form is to be completed in full and carry the competitor's Club's endorsement. Nomination forms must be lodged at the SLSSNB Office by COB **Monday 14<sup>th</sup> October 2019** and can be emailed to [surfsportsadmin@surflifesaving.net.au](mailto:surfsportsadmin@surflifesaving.net.au).

The Chairman of Selectors is to ensure that the Interbranch Team, including any team reserves, is published on the SLSSNB website following the selection process. The Branch will also send to each team member, together with the nominated reserves, a letter informing the team member of their obligations and training schedules.

### SELECTION CRITERIA

To be selected in the Interbranch team, results from the 2019 Branch, State and Australian Championship will be considered at the discretion of the selectors, as well as results of any selection carnivals endorsed by the SLSSNB Interbranch Selection Panel.

The primary order of preference for individual selection (for the Junior positions) are as follows -

1. Swim, Board, Iron, Sprints and Flags results from 2019 State Titles
2. Swim, Board, Iron, Sprints and Flags results from the Newport Interbranch Selection Trial to be held on 26th October 2019



# CIRCULAR

## SURF LIFE SAVING SYDNEY NORTHERN BEACHES

For further information regarding the selection process, please refer to *Circular 201909-01 – SLSSNB Interbranch Team Selection Policy*, which is available on the Branch Website.

Any rule/guideline that is not covered in the Selection Policy is to be referred to the SLSA Australian Team Selection Guideline (July 2018) including the SLSA guidelines on pregnancy covered in the Member Protection Policy 6.05. Clubs are asked to familiarise themselves with this policy on the SLSA website.

### TEAM TRAINING

All team members will then be asked to commit to the team and observe the training disciplines that will be set down by the Interbranch Coaching group, including training dates, and mandatory team appearances.

### SELECTION CARNIVALS

As well as the previously mentioned past results being used as part of the selection criteria, the following carnivals will be also used by selectors to assist in the selection process (for Junior competitors only) –

- Dee Why Bennett Craft Carnival – 20th October
- Newport Junior Selection Trial - 26th October

### CODE OF CONDUCT

All competitors are required to abide by the Surf Life Saving Sydney Northern Beaches Interbranch Team Code of Conduct. A copy can be found on the Branch website (*Surf Sports > High Performance > Interbranch Team*).

### COMPETITOR LEVY

Please note that there will be a \$220 levy for all team members, which contributes to the costs associated with the event, which includes entry fees, team uniform, accommodation, catering, and transport for the Interbranch Titles.

The competitor levy will be invoiced to your club and must be paid to Surf Life Saving Sydney Northern Beaches prior to the Interbranch Championships weekend. Team Management reserves the right to remove a competitor from the team in the event the levy is not paid.
