	to provide IRB water safety for the Championships as outlined within this circular.

CLUB IRB WATER SAFETY QUOTAS

The identified clubs and quotas for the supply of IRB's and also drivers and crews for the 2020 Branch Championships has been set based on expected participation numbers. It will be adjusted once entries close to correlate with the entry numbers from each club.

JUNIOR BRANCH CHAMPIONSHIPS IRB REQUIREMENTS – SUNDAY FEBRUARY 3RD

The Junior Branch Championships will utilise 3 water area. As such there is a requirement for 18 IRB shifts. These are split into 9 shifts for Water Safety, and 9 shifts for Judge in Boat roles.

The following clubs are required to provide the following shifts of IRB drivers/Crews for the Junior Branch Championships -

Clubs that are required to provide a fully operational IRB are Manly LSC, Mona Vale SLSC, Freshwater SLSC, North Curl Curl SLSC, North Steyne SLSC, Collaroy SLSC and Queenscliff SLSC (2 IRBs).

Note: 1 x IRB shift equates to 1 x IRB driver and 1 x IRB Crewperson, of 2 hours duration.

OPENS & MASTERS BRANCH CHAMPIONSHIPS IRB REQUIREMENTS – SATURDAY FEBRUARY 8TH

The Opens Branch Championships will utilise 3 water area. As such there is a requirement for 18 IRB shifts. These are split into 9 shifts for Water Safety, and 9 shifts for Judge in Boat roles.

The following clubs are required to provide the following shifts of IRB drivers/Crews for the Open Branch Championships -

OPEN & MASTERS SURF BOATS BRANCH CHAMPIONSHIPS IRB REQUIREMENTS – SATURDAY MARCH 21ST

The Open & Masters Boat Branch Championships will utilise 1 water area. As such there is a requirement for 6 IRB shifts. These are split into 3 shifts for Water Safety, and 3 shifts for Judge in Boat roles.

The following clubs are required to provide the following shifts of IRB drivers/Crews for the Opens & Masters Surf Boat Championships -
