BACKGROUND

In 2016, SLSSNB was granted a 21-year lease with Crown Lands for the building known as Surfcom at Fisherman's Beach. Leading up to the signing of the lease with Crown Lands there was community consultation in regard to the usage and possible future plans for the building moving forward. With time passed since the lease has been signed the building is now showing signs of some major maintenance works needing to be carried out.

The building currently houses the SLSSNB Operations Centre "Surfcom" working with Northern Beaches Council Lifeguard services. SLSSNB also sub-leases the downstairs area with Reef Care and other partners of the Coastal Environment Centre.

The intent is to look at the future proofing of the building for all organisations that currently use it and to modernise the facility.

SCOPE

SLSSNB are looking for interested people to form the building committee to develop a Master Plan for the site and work within the Griffith Park Management Plan. The committee would look at all aspects of the usage of the site and the possible expansion for increased services and other community groups. The committee would also look at such aspects as design, funding, grants and development applications.

The committee at times may seek information and consultation with current user groups of the building to build a wholistic approach to the Master Plan.
