INTRODUCTION



AS PART OF THE NATIONAL YOUTH REVIEW, THE AGE MANAGER COURSE AND ITS PROCESSES HAVE BEEN REVIEWED. SOME OF THE OUTCOMES FROM THE REVIEW INCLUDED:

- Increase support for Age Managers
- Build Capacity
- Awareness of the pool of active Age Managers
- Support and encourage those delivering nippers who aren't accredited to upskill
- Build an Age Manager Mentor Course









PRE-REQUISITES

- Current financial member of a club
- Current Working with Children Check recorded on SurfGuard
- Age Manager course / accredited Age Manager
- Completed online Child Safe Awareness course
- Age Manager with 3 years experience (within last 5 years)
- Endorsed by Junior Activities Coordinator to complete the course
- Knowledge and understanding of Age Manager Guides (JDR's)





WHAT DOES THE ROLE DO?

- Responsible for the training, mentoring, and upskilling of new and existing age managers at a club
- Main contact to Branch/State Centre for all matters related to Age Managers
- Includes recruitment and retention, training, on beach mentoring and pre-season briefings
- Could work across multiple clubs throughout Branch or State (as appropriate)
- Works closely with the club's Junior Activities Coordinator to ensure the safe and successful delivery of nippers
- Is the main contact for Age Managers within the club





WHAT DOES THE ROLE DO?

- Keep up to date with information from Branch/State Centres
- Is available for Nipper sessions to support Age Managers on the beach
- Assist at new Age Managers inductions, while providing advice and guidance on delivering nippers
- Can present the face-to-face Age Managers course option
- Conduct and endorse the on-the-beach technical and mentoring sessions
- Instruct Age Managers course participants how to set up and pack up the beach for nipper activities, as well as teach the core lifesaving skills





WHAT DOES THE ROLE DO?

- Mentor Age Manager course participants to facilitate learning and follow JDR lesson plans
- Sign off third-party forms for new Age Managers
- Attend briefings to keep up to date with the latest
- Supervise Age Managers / Assistants under 18 years of age
- Check in regularly with Age Managers
- Liaise with Branch/State and conduct a pre-season briefing with Age Managers

- Gain mutual trust and respect
- Be willing to learn and share
